CrossPoint has been reactive in our church planting strategy. If someone desired to plant a CrossPoint church we worked with them and made available the resources needed to be a CrossPoint campus.

Person to Plant

CrossPoint leadership is constantly searching and training potential church planters. We enlist potential church planters to enter our training process called CrossPoint University (CPU). We discover potential planters by cooperating with the following groups:

- Existing CrossPoint campuses
- Existing Network Churches
- KNCSB
- Local Baptist Associations

Passion to Plant

The church planter must exhibit a passion to plant a church. CrossPoint will assist them by administering assessments, which include SOI, Myer Briggs, Strength Finders and Prepare Enrich (for married couples). We will interview the potential candidate and invite them to participate in our two year CPU program.

Place to Plant

The skills, gift and the passion of the planter determine the place to plant. We will launch a church plant in a location where there is a person who has a passion to plant a church in the place where God is sending the planter.

Rural Church Planting

CrossPoint's vision is to reach 10% of Kansas. CrossPoint is establishing a network that will be available for anyone that desires to be autonomous and self-sustaining. The network will be called "networkchurchnow." CrossPoint will assist and provide the necessary resources for Bible study groups, house churches, church plants or existing churches.

CrossPoint Campus New Starts



1. Pray for a person
2. Discover a person with a passion to plant
3. Assess the church planter (SOI, Myers Briggs, Strength Finders and Prepare Enrich)
4. Interview Church Planter
5. Identify City and potential leaders in the city
6. Discover resources available
7. Locate and secure start up location and facilities
8. Review and achieve CrossPoint constants for start up
9. Enlist volunteer Worship and Children Leadership
10. Research and find necessary equipment needed for start up
11. Plan Launch date
12. Start with Video and Grow Groups

(Bible study groups, house churches, church plants or existing churches.)



1. Pray for person, group or church willing to be a networkchurchnow new start
2. Identify person, group or existing church willing to partner
 - Perform Background check and references
 - Review Application
 - Invite team or leaders to CrossPoint Hutchinson for a weekend training and worship service
 - ▶ Train on equipment and resource box (see point 3)
 - ▶ Attend Saturday night worship and technical session prior to service
 - ▶ Participate in a commissioning service and time of prayer
